Hulphond Netherlands

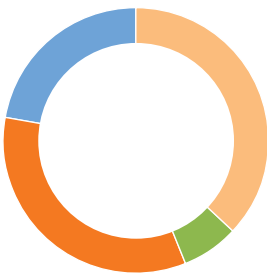
