The history of this art collection dates back to the beginning of the 20th century and contains several disciplines nowadays: Dutch painting, photography, works on paper, glass art, sculptures and video art. We also purchase artworks by the nominees* of the NN Art Award, presented yearly at the art fair Art Rotterdam.








