Nationale - Nederlanden uses information from the Basic Registration Persons (BRP) to keep your employees' personal data up to date. In this Eventcard we provide you with more information.

The following events in the lives of your employees are reported to us automatically from the BRP.

- Marriage or a registered partnership
- Divorce or end of a registered partnership
- Change of address in The Netherlands

With an unspecified partner cover, partner mutations have no effect on the premium

Most pension schemes have a partner's and orphan's pension insured regardless of the civil status or the present of children. When time comes the details of the surviving relatives will be requested from the BRP and we check if the survivors are eligible for a benefit. In our pension scheme's we name this an unspecified partner cover.

What if a you have a specified partner cover?

The easiest way to check if you have a specified partner cover is to log on to Mijn NN Zakelijk, select a member and see if you can register a partner. In that case you have a specified partner cover. When you register a partner we will insure a coverage, this will have an effect on the premium.
